5. LOGISTIC

the ski event will be held in Limone Piemonte (CN) zona Tre Amis Quota 1400, a staff member will welcome the athletes from 9.30 am at the local box office.

The sailing events will be held in Imperia Porto Maurizio by Yacht Club Imperia, via Scarincio 146.

6.ADMISSION

All the participants should be members of their national federation for the year 2014, and should show their insurance certificate including: name of the sailor or boat specific, with a responsibility coverage of at least 1000.000 euros which should be valid during the races. These documents should be shown at the moment of the cash up.

7. NUMBER OF RACES, CLASSIFICATION AND SCORING SYSTEM

6 races are possible (4 races for the cadets), with a maximum of 3 per day. A discard will be possible according to the point A of the RRS.
Two races per day are possible for the cadets.
Discards: from 1 to 3 races: none ; fom 4 to 6 : one
