PRE – NOTICE OF RACE

The V Semana Olímpica de Vela Comunitat Valenciana, will be held in the Comunitat Valenciana from 7th to 10th February 2019., both inclusive. Organised by RCN Torrevieja, RCRAlicante, CNJavea, RCNValencia, FVCV with the approval of RFEV. For the Laser 4.7, Laser Radial, Laser Standard, RSX, Techno 293, Raceboard, 420 y Europe classes the CVOW2019 is qualifying event for valencians sailors. For RC10M Class will be Association Cup. This Regatta is included at the Spanish Olympic Sailing Circuit (COEV)

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.3 [NP][DP] May be required to the coaches and personal support to wear a personal flotation devices at all times while afloat.
- 1.4 [NP][DP] Prescriptions of the RFEV will apply and these are available on: http://www.rfev.es/uploaded_files/Document_3219_20180719092630_es.pdf
- 1.5 In all the rules governing this regatta the notation [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence

2. ADVERTISING [DP]

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising provided by the organization. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter completing the on-line entry form on the website and paying the required fees. www.cvolympicweek.com.
On-line entry opens on 1 October 2018.
Entries must be received and paid no later than 20th January 2019 to qualify for the early entry fee. The entry deadline is 31st January 2019 but the Organising Committee reserves the right to accept entries received after that date. Entry in the event is not ended until payment and registration are completed.



- 3.2 Competitor must deliver the following documents before the end of the registration:
- *2019 Federative License (Spanish sailors)
 - *Civil insurance of at least 1,500,000 (foreign sailors)
 - *DN or Passport
 - *Proof of the payment of the entry fees
 - *Class card
 - *Measurement Certificate (if is required by the Class)
- 3.3 World Sailing Eligibility shall apply. Each competitor shall be registered as a WS Sailor on the website World Sailing: <https://members.sailing.org/sailors/isafsailor/index.php>
- 3.4 Competitor under 18 years of age shall present a signed completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration format registration. The forms are available on the event website: www.cvolympicweek.com
- 3.5 The regatta is open to the following Classes and categories

- 3.7 The organising authority may cancel an event if the minimum number of entries has not been received by midnight (local time), 31st January 2019. Competitors will be notified of cancelled events by email and it will be also posted on the event website. The entry fees for cancelled events will be refunded.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Fees are stated in Euros and they include any local taxes. Entries received and paid by 20th January 2019 will qualify for the early Entry fee. Payment must be made through the website at the following link www.cvolympicweek.com

4.2 If an entry is cancelled by the competitor, the entry fee will be refunded as follows

5. FORMAT

5.1 The Classes will sail in a single group, except that if there were more than 70 registered, the competition format would be in groups, into a qualifying series and a final series. The final format will be published to the Sailing Instructions.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration for competitors, coaches and team leaders, and equipment inspection is scheduled between 9.30h and 19.30 on Thursday 7th february for all clases, and between 9.00h and 10.30 on friday 8th february for all clases at each venue, except 49er and Laser Radial classes that it will be only on Thursday.
- 6.2 The first briefing for coaches and team leaders is scheduled for 18:00h on thursday, 7st february 2019 at the corresponding venue.

6.4 The Schedule time of the warning signal on 8th of February is at 1200 h

6.5 On the last day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 16:00 h.

7. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION [NP] [DP]

- 7.1 Competitors shall provide any measurement certificates required by class rules at the time of registration.
- 7.2 The boats will be subject to measurement controls at any time during the event. The inspection procedures will be detailed in the Sailing or Measurement Instructions.
- 7.3 The equipment limitations, as specified in the class rules, shall apply.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1 Sailing Instructions will be available beginning 15th January 2019 at registration, TOA of each venue and the Virtual TOA in the event website.

9. VENUES

- 9.1 The regatta venues will be Real Club Náutico Torrevieja, Real Club de Regatas Alicante at its facilities in La Cantera, Real Club Nautico de Valencia and Club Náutico de Javea.

- 9.2 The racing area will be in Torreveja Bay, Alicante Bay, Javea Bay, and in front of the Pinedo-Saler beach in Valencia, Comunitat Valenciana, Spain.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1 The courses for the Olympic Classes will be Windward/Leeward or Trapezoid except that any other courses adopted by World Sailing for the 2020 Olympic Sailing Competition may also be used.
- 10.2 For the rest of the classes, they will be detailed in the sailing instructions.

11. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 11.1 For the 49er, 49erFX, 29er, and Nacra 17 Classes, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12. SCORING

- 12.1 Two races are required to be completed for the validity of the championship
- 12.2 (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
© For the Laser, Radial and Laser 4.7 classes, when 8 or more races have been completed, a boat's series scores will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

13. SUPPORT BOATS AND PERSONNEL [NP][DP]

- 13.1 All support boats shall be registered with the organizing authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations. The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 13.2 All support boats shall be equipped by a V-F radio
- 13.3 All coaches and team leaders shall present the coach boat insurance. Spanish coaches must also present a valid Licencia de Técnico (RFEV).

14. BOAT PARK [NP][DP]

- 14.1 The boats will return to their assigned area every day in the esplanade or port. The boats will not leave their beached area during the regatta unless written permission is given by the race committee.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be published in the TOA of each of the venues.

16. INSURANCE [NP][DP]

- 16.1 Each participating crew shall present a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability coverage of at least 1.500.000 Euros (or equivalent) per incident. Federative license in the case of Spanish participants.



17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta at their entirely own risk. The Organising Authority will accept no liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. See rule 4, Decision to Race.
"The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone".

18. MEDIA RIGHTS [NP][DP]

- 18.1 By participating in the CVOW competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 18.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.
- 18.3 Competitors may be required for interviews at the regatta.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

TRAINING

All those participating in the CVOW2019, who have registered and confirmed the payment, will be able to train from the 1st of February to the 6th of February.

Crews wishing to travel before the dates of the regatta for training purposes must request so in writing to their corresponding Club.
