1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority is the Malahide Yacht Club in conjunction with the Irish 420 Class Association.

2 RULES

Racing will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to International 420 Class dinghies, sailed by helms and crews who are members of the Irish International 420 Class Association.

3.2 Eligible Crews may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Brian McDowell.

3.3 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** All helms and crews who are under 18 years of age must submit declarations signed by their parent or guardian with their entry form or at event registration.

4 ENTRY FEE

The Entry fee is €80.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Racing will take place over two days 4th & 5th May.
- 5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal of first race is 11:55 on Saturday 23rd and 10.55 on Sunday 24th.
- 5.3 Registration shall take place in the Malahide Yacht Club Race Office on Saturday 4th May from 09:00 to 10:00.
- 5.4 Six races are scheduled. Not more than 4 races will be sailed on either day.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and conform to class rules.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be issued at the host club on registration.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 The Malahide Yacht Club Broadmeadows Dinghy Centre is located on Sea Road, Malahide. All competing boats shall launch from and return to the Club during the event.
- 8.2 The racing area will be on the Broadmeadow Estuary.

9 THE COURSES

The course will be Trapezoid with an Outer or Inner Loop or Windward/Leeward.

10 SAFETY REGULATIONS

Each crew member shall wear personal buoyancy in accordance with the sailing instructions. All boats must have an appropriate tow line, taped to the deck in accordance with International 420 class rules.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. Where 4 or more races have been completed the worst score of each boat may be excluded in calculating her total score.

12 PRIZES

The Leinster Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the 420 event and the Aloha Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the silver fleet. Prizes will be awarded to the helm and crew of the top 3 Gold Fleet 420s and top 3 Silver 420s. The Organising Authority may award additional prizes.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

The Broadmeadows Estuary is a Statutory Nature Reserve and Special Area of Conservation. The use of power boats on the Broadmeadows Estuary is restricted and requires a licence from Fingal County Council. Support boats shall register with the race office and will be required to comply with the provisions published in the Sailing Instructions for the event.

14 LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of €1.5 million per event or the equivalent.
