



## SINGAPORE NATIONAL 420 CHAMPIONSHIPS 2013

### NOTICE OF RACE

The Singapore National 420 Championship will be held at the National Sailing Centre, Singapore on Wednesday 19 June to Sunday 23 June 2013. The Organising Authority is the SingaporeSailing Federation.

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in ***The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)***.
- 1.2 National authority prescriptions of RRS Part 4 preambles 40 will apply.
- 1.3 For medal races, ISAF Addendum Q, Umpired Fleet Racing will apply and will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Regulation 20, Appendix 1 - Advertising Code.

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of 420 class that are members of a club affiliated to SingaporeSailing, or in the case of international entrants are members of a club affiliated to their own national authority.
- 3.2 All Singaporean competitors must have at least SingaporeSailing Level 2 Proficiency certification, or its equivalent for International participants.
- 3.3 Proof of club membership is required upon submission of entry form. Sailors without valid club membership shall not be eligible to participate in this regatta.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to

Payment of entry fees for overseas entrants can be made upon arrival.

3.5 A minimum of 6 entries in each class is required to form an event.

#### **4 FEES**

4.1 Entry fees (inclusive of GST) are as follows:

Refund will only be given if the regatta is canceled.

#### **5 FORMAT OF RACING**

5.1 The regatta comprises of two events;

- a) Opening series
- b) Medal race

5.2 For opening series, 13 races are scheduled. If at least 6 races have been completed in the opening series, the top 10 finisher of each class will advance to the medal race.

#### **6 SCHEDULE**

The schedule is as follows:

6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100hrs.

6.2 Races in the opening series may be sail ahead of schedule except that there must be at least 1 race on the last day.

6.3 There should be no more than four scheduled races each day.

6.4 On the last day of the opening series, no warning signal will be made after 1400hrs, except if there has been less than 6 races completed, thus the opening series will continue for that class with the last warning signal to be made no later than 1600hrs.

6.5 Daily skippers briefing will be at 0945hrs in the Auditorium.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available from **13 June 2013** at National Sailing Centre, Singapore and [www.sailing.org.sg](http://www.sailing.org.sg).

## **8 VENUE**

8.1 The racing venue will be at the National Sailing Centre, 1500 East Coast Parkway Singapore 468963. Attachment 1 shows the location of the racing area.

## **9 THE COURSES**

The diagrams in Attachment 2 show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be left.

## **10 PENALTY SYSTEM**

10.1 Appendix P will apply as changed by instructions 10.2 and 10.3

10.2 On the first protest, if a boat is protested after she has finished, she will be given a scoring penalty of 6 points, without a hearing. If her score results in a score worse than DSQ, the penalty will be corresponding to DSQ.

10.3 Rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any protest after the first one.

10.4 Action taken under Appendix P will not be grounds for redress by a competitor.

## **11 SCORING**

11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply. RRS B8 is deleted.

11.2 A maximum of 13 races are scheduled. A minimum of 5 races is required to constitute a series.

11.3 When fewer than 6 opening series have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.4 When 6 or more opening series have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. However, the score from Medal Race will not be excluded.

11.5 In a medal race, a boat's score shall be double the number of the points specified in RRS Appendix A4.1, and the score for that race shall not be excluded from the fleet racing score.

11.6 Ties in the fleet racing score between boats with different medal race points score shall be broken in favour of the boat that scored in the medal race. This changes RRS Appendix A8.

## **12 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be identified by a white flag with the letter corresponding to the course area.

**13 BOAT STORAGE**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park.

**14 BOAT CHARTER**

A limited number of sailing boats and coach boats will be available **for overseas entrants only**. These boats will be issued on first come first served basis. Please note that the chartered boats will only reserve when we receive the form. Kindly refer to Attachment 3 for boat charter details.

**15 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**16 PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded to the overall top 3 winners.

**17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**18 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid and adequate third-party liability insurance.

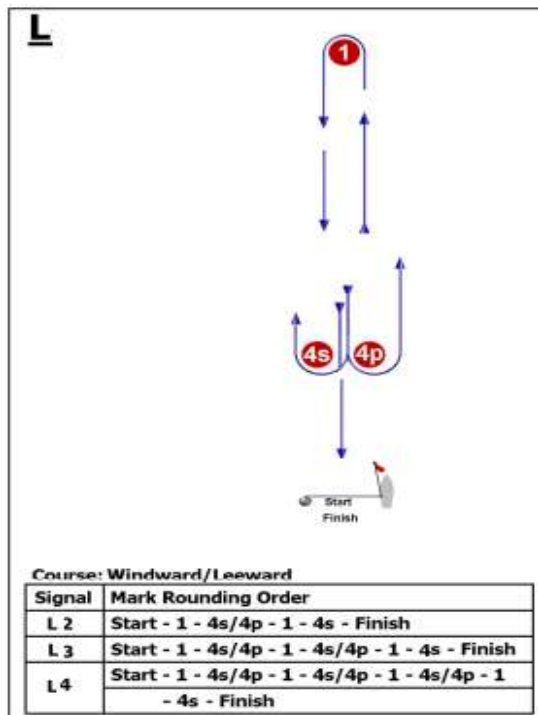
