## 1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the special regulations of YA, the rules of the International 420 Class, (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY:

2.1 Each boat must be a financial member of the Western Australian International 420 Class Association.

2.2 Each competitor must be a financial member of a yacht or sailing club that is affiliated with a National Authority recognised by ISAF and a Yachting Australia silver card holder.

2.3 Substitute competitors will be allowed.

2.4 No more than two suits of sails and two sets of spars may be used during the regatta.

2.5 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form and emailing to [sailingoffice@fsc.com.au](mailto:sailingoffice@fsc.com.au)

2.6 Insurance: Each boat shall be covered by insurance for third party risks in a sum of not less than \$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) for any one incident. By completing the Entry Form and signing the declaration, competitors are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.

## 3. FEES:

There is no entry fee.

## 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

It is intended to complete 6 races.

Racing will be conducted with the FSC regular racing with fixed line starts.

5.1 Measurement inspections may be made at any time during the regatta.

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

## 7. REGATTA SITE:

The regatta will be conducted from the Fremantle Sailing Club Inc.

## 8. RACING AREA:

Racing will be conducted on the FSC club course area north of Fish Rocks, and option of Leighton on Sunday, Indian Ocean, Fremantle.

## 9. COURSES:

The courses shall be windward/leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. SCORING:

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A of the RRS will apply.

3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

Protests arising from participation in this regatta shall be subject to mediation.
