1. Organizers

2. Racing rules

2.1. The Regatta will be governed by the following rules

World Sailing's „Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016” (hereinafter referred to as RRS),
The General Sailing Instructions (GSI) and Security Policies issued by the Hungarian Sailing Federation (MVSZ) valid for 2016,
The Class Rules of the participating classes.
Appendix P "Special Procedures for Rule 42"
Current Regatta Regulations
In case of any conflict between the Hungarian and English versions of any documents, the Hungarian version should prevail.

2.2. Eligibility

All boats or competitors have to fulfill the requirements of MVSZ 2016. Regatta Regulations 1.1.

3. Entry

3.1. Entry in person

International participants can register their entrance in person on Thursday July 21, 2016 between 16.00-19:00 pm at the International Sailing Center (8230 Balatonfüred, Zákonyi Ferenc u. 8.) at the „Aluház” Race Office.

3.2. Entry fee: HUF 6.800 / person (~ 22 EUR / person)

4. Informing racers on the shore

- 4.1. The official notice board is located next to the Race Office at the International Sailing Center
- 4.2. The Race Committee will have a briefing every day at a close proximity of the official notice board 90 minutes ahead of the first warning signal
- 4.3. Signals made ashore will be displayed at the main flag post located at the International Sailing Center
- 4.4. In case a signal is displayed above the course or class flag, then that signal will be valid for that course or class only.

Courses	Classes	Flag
Course „A”	F18, M3	yellow
Course „B”	OP, LR, L 4,7, 420	red

- 4.5. In case of postpone is signaled ashore, Flag D with one sound means ‘The start signal will be made not less than 40 minutes after flag D is displayed.’
- 4.6. The online notice board on www.hunsail.hu is only informal one.

5. Race Schedule

- 5.1. The organizers plan to have total of eight races during the Regatta, with up to 3 races a day scheduled as follows.

- 5.2. The planned length of a race is 60 minutes
- 5.3. No warning signal will be made after July 24, 15:00 pm.
- 5.4. The planned start sequence on Course „B” is: **420**, Laser Radial open, Laser 4.7, OP

6. Starting Area

- 6.1. Those boats that did not have their warning signals yet should leave the start area by a more than 50 meters of distance.

7. Class flags

Class	Class Flag
420	blue/black
Laser Radial	green/ red
Laser 4.7	yellow / red
Optimist	yellow / black

8. Race course

- 8.1. The course will be set in the triangle water area of Balatonfüred – Tihany – Siófok having a trapeze shape course as shown in the appendix:
- 8.2. The marks are the following:

MARKS	DESCRIPTION
1, 2, 3/3, 4/4	Yellow cylinder
offset	Yellow cylinder
modification	Red cylinder
start	red-white striped flag mark
finish	blue-white striped flag mark

9. Modification of the next leg

9.1. Race Committee will use a new marks for the modification and removing the old ones.

10. Official boats

10.1. The Official boats will be marked as follows:

Type of boat	Flag
Race Committee	white flag with „RC” written on it
Jury	yellow flag with „JURY” written on it
Media	white flag with „PRESS” written on it

11. Time limits and finishing times

11.1. Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish (DNF). The competitors must clear the finishing line by more than 50 meters.

12. Security

12.1. Personal buoyancy is mandatory for every competitor at all times while afloat, except the occasion of a short dress change

12.2. Coaches, coach other boats, rescue plan [NP],[DP]: At the entry, the coaches, the coach boats and the supervised boats sail no. shall be named. One coach boat can supervise max 10 boats on the same course. The motorboats not participating in the race-organization, can enter the start-, finish- and race area only in case of rescue. The recommended waiting areas for these boats are displayed on the attached course maps. All coach boat shall be able to communicate with the RC on radio (VHF). All coaches must report if his/her racer has given up a race, or is earlier leaving the race area for any reason. Personal buoyancy is recommended for staff of the coach boats. The rescue plan of the regatta will be announced on the coaches' meeting.

13. Scoring

13.1. When 5 or more races have been completed, one boat's worst race will be discarded.

14. Prizes

14.1. In each class place I is given a cup price, while places I-III. are given a medal prize.

14.2. The time for the Prize giving ceremony will be displayed on the official notice board.

15. Media rights

15.1. By participating in the event competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their partners the right in perpetuity to make, use, show and sell, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation

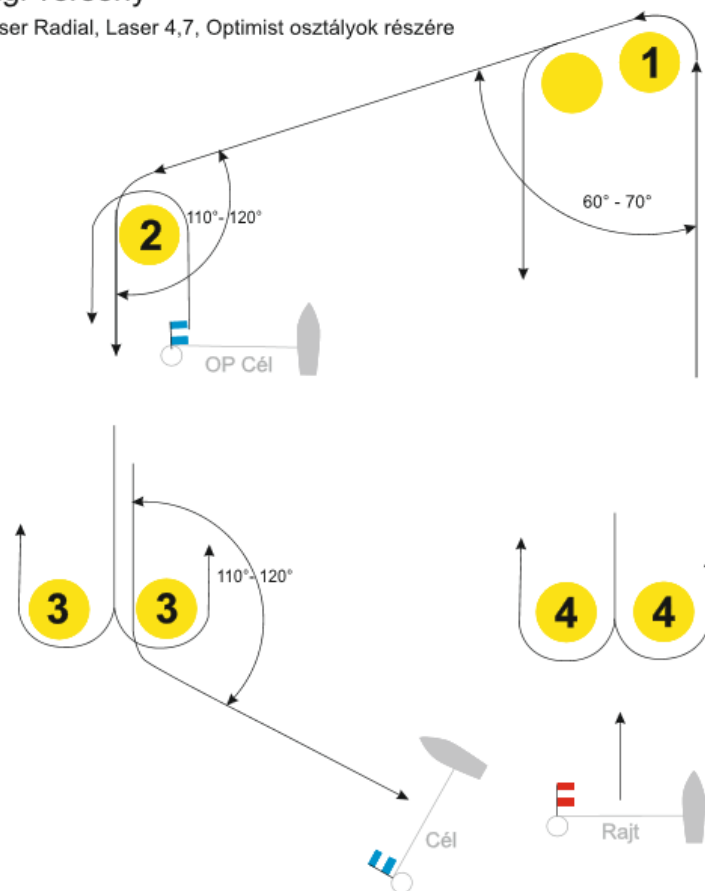
16. Disclaimer of liability:

By entering the regatta, all competitors accept all requirements of the Notice of Race and fully fit to them.
