Organization : The Centre Nautique de Crozon-Morgat, under the authority of the FFV, in conjunction with Uniqua France, is organizing, from the 7th to the 12th July 2017, the Coupe Nationale 420, in Crozon-Morgat

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, "RCV 2013-2016"
- 1.2 National prescriptions for foreign competitors are defined in joined appendix "prescription"
- 1.3 Class 420 rules, including class rule C1.2.1 in modification of RCV42.
- 1.3 Federal regulations.
- 1.4 Official language of the regatta will be French. In the event of conflict in the translation the French text shall prevail.

2. ADVERTISING

In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 (Advertising Code), as modified by the advertising regulation of the FFVoile, boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the class 420
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter on-site by completing the attached form and sending it along with the regulation of fees required, at the following address:

3.3 Competitors (each crew member) having a FFVoile licence shall present to registration :

- their valid FFVoile licence with medical stamp, or accompanied with a medical certificate (dated less than one year) certifying the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition and a parental authorization for the minors,
- if necessary a valid authorization to display advertising on boat
- the measurement form of the boat

3.4 Foreign competitors (each crew member) without a FFVoile licence shall present:

- A proof of their membership to an ISAF member national authority.
- The measurement form of the boat.
- A proof to be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1 500 000 Euros.
- A medical certificate (in French or in English) dated less than one year, certifying the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition and a parental authorization for the minors.

4. FEES

Required fees:

120€ before the 30th june

150€ after the 30th june

120€ for french bachelors, reimboursable coasts in case of re-take exams

5. SCHEDULE

5.4 The last race cut-off time for Wednesday 12th July 2017, will be given by agreement on Saturday 8th July before 19:00.

5.5 Saturday, July 8, at 18:00, opening ceremony

5.6 Wednesday, July 12, Awards after the last race.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions and their appendices will be available during confirmation of registration on the 7th and 8th July.

6.2 The Maguet Challenge is on Saturday July 8th, with 1 race in fleet (scoring will be carried out with the first three crews of any region). The race type and sailing instructions will be defined, with amendment the Friday July 7th, before 20:00

Only registered competitors will be authorized to participate to Maguet Challenge.

7. COURSES

7.1 A winward-leeward course will be used.

7.2 The location of the racing areas will be described in the appendix RACING AREA.

8. SCORING

Three (3) races are required to be completed to complete the event

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing or receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows :

- Gold Podium
- Silver Podium
- Foreign Podium
- Girls Podium.

11. DECISION TO RACE

The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone. Consequently, accepting to participate in a race or to continue racing, the competitor disclaims the organizing authority of any liability for damage (material and/or personal injury).

ANNEXE PRESCRIPTIONS FEDERALES

FFVoile Prescriptions to RRS 2013-2016

Applying to foreign competitors

RRS 64.3

FFVoile Prescription (*):

The jury may ask the parties to the protest, prior to checking procedures, a deposit covering the cost of checking arising from a protest concerning class rules.

RRS 67

FFVoile Prescription (*):

Any question about or request of damages arising from an incident involving a boat bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing or International Regulation to Prevent Collision at Sea depends on the appropriate courts and will not be dealt by the jury.

RRS 70. 5

FFVoile Prescription (*):

In such circumstances, the written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile shall be received before publishing the notice of race and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

RRS 78

FFVoile Prescription (*):

The boat's owner or other person in charge shall, under his sole responsibility, make sure moreover that his boat comply with the equipment and security rules required by the laws, by-laws and regulations of the Administration.

RRS 86.3

FFVoile Prescription (*):

An organizing authority wishing to change a rule listed in RRS 86.1 in order to develop or test new rules shall first submit the changes to the FFVoile, in order to obtain its written approval and shall report the results to FFVoile after the event. Such authorization shall be mentioned in the notice of race and in the sailing instructions and shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.

RRS 88

FFVoile Prescription (*):

Prescriptions of the FFVoile shall be neither changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions, except for events for which an international jury has been appointed.

In such case, the prescriptions marked with an asterisk (*) shall be neither changed nor deleted in the notice of race and sailing instructions. (The official translation of the prescriptions, downloadable on the FFVoile website www.ffvoile.fr , shall be the only translation used to comply with RRS 90.2(b)).

RRS 91

FFVoile Prescription (*):

The appointment of an international jury meeting the requirements of Appendix N is subject to prior written approval of the Fédération Française de Voile. Such notice of approval shall be posted on the official notice board during the event.
