1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.3 The Australian Sailing Prescriptions applies to all entries.
Appendix P will apply as changed by instruction 2.5
RRS P2.3 will not apply and RRS P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.
- 1.4 (SP) Australian Sailing Special Regulation Part 2 Off the Beach Boats, Section 5.01 Personal Flotation Devices will apply. It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that the personal flotation devices comply with a standard equivalent to those listed in the regulations.
- 1.5 The Optimist Green Fleet will be governed by the World Sailing Introductory Rules of Sailing.
- 1.6 The use of helmets for Nacra 15 (conform EN1385 standard) for both helm and crew is mandatory during racing.

2 Advertising and Bow Numbers

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and/or advertising as required by the organising authority.

3 Eligibility & Entry

- 3.1 Competitors and coaches shall enter the event by completing the on-line entry form on the event website www.youthchamps.org.au and paying the required fees. On-line entry opens on 5 July, 2017 and late entry fees apply after the midnight 8 September, 2017.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to the following classes.

- 3.3 Other classes may be included at the discretion of the Organising Authority.
- 3.4 Competitors must be under 19 years of age at 31 December 2017.
- 3.5 For competitors under 18 years of age, a parent/guardian shall sign a consent and declaration form at registration. The form will be available at the regatta office.
- 3.6 All competitors shall be members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing or a World Sailing MYA.
- 3.7 By entering the championships competitors agree to comply with The Code of Conduct agreement contained in the online registration.

4 Entry Fees

- 4.1 Fees are stated in AUD and include any local taxes (GST).

4.2 If any entry is cancelled by the competitor, the entry fee will be refunded as follows:

5 Schedule

- 5.1 Registration for competitors and support boats will be open from 1600hrs till 1800hrs on 21st September, and from 0830hrs till 1000hrs on 22nd September 2017.
- 5.2 Registration must be completed prior to 1000hrs on 22nd September 2017.
- 5.3 The first briefing for all Competitors and Support Boats will take place in the Commodore's room on the 1st floor of the club house at 1030hrs 22nd September 2017.
- 5.4 The schedule of races and dates for racing is as follows:

Race 1 – 2	Friday 22 September	1230hrs
Race 3 – 4	Saturday 23 September	1000hrs
Race 5 – 6	Saturday 23 September	1400hrs
Race 7 – 8	Sunday 24 September	0930hrs

- 5.6 No warning signal will be made after 1200hrs on the last scheduled day of racing.

6 Equipment Inspection

- 6.1 Boats may be subject to equipment inspection at any time during the event.
- 6.2 Each boat shall have a serviceable beach trailer/dolly. All beach trailers/dollies shall be clearly labelled with the sail number of the boat to which it belongs. It is recommended that the beach trailers/dollies are fitted with pneumatic types at least 60mm wide (or equivalent) and have adequate padding.

7 Sailing Instructions

- 7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available one week before the event on the website and will be posted on the Official Notice Board. Other documents governing the event may be published with the Sailing Instructions.

8 Venue

- 8.1 The regatta will be conducted at Keppel Bay Sailing Club, Anzac Parade, Yeppoon.

9 The Course

- 9.1 The courses will be Windward/Leeward, Triangle, Box or Trapezoid.

10 Penalty System

- 10.1 For the Nacra 15, 49er, 49erFX, and 29er events, RRS 44.1 and RRS P2.1 are changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 Jury

- 11.1 A National Jury will be constituted in accordance with “Addendum A – Australian Sailing policy on the denial of the right of appeals”. Decisions of the National jury will be final, in accordance with RRS Rule 70.5. A copy of the letter of approval issued by Australian Sailing will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

12 Scoring

- 12.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute as series.
- 12.2 When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3 When from six to eight races have been completed, a boat’s series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.4 The scoring for the Queensland Sabot Championships 2017 Teams Trophies shall be:
The South Queensland Sabot Association or the North Queensland Sabot Association with lowest aggregate final scores of its top four (4) placed Sabot 1 Ups will win the Senior Sabot Team Trophy.

The South Queensland Sabot Association or the North Queensland Sabot Association with the lowest aggregate final scores of its top two (2) placed Sabot 2 Ups will win the Junior Sabot Team Trophy. Where an association enters fewer than the required number of boats to form a team, for each race the unfilled placings shall be scored points for 'DNC'.

13 Support Boats

- 13.1 All support boats shall be registered with the Organising Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event support boat regulations. The Organising Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion. Local marine regulations specify the safety equipment to be carried and conditions under which life jackets (PFD 1) are to be worn. A copy of the regulations is available at [safety-equipment-for-powered-vessels](#) and [personal-flotation-devices](#).
- 13.2 All support boats shall collect from the regatta office a regatta registration number/flag and display it at all times while afloat.

14 Berthing

- 14.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the dinghy park or on water trotline for support boats (small boats only) as described by the Organising Authority during registration and check-in. Trailers shall not to be left within the boat park during the regatta. All trailers maybe stored in the areas provided by the organising authority. Any trailers left within the boat park may be moved / relocated at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

15 Radio Communications

- 15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions, text messages or cellular phone calls while racing except in an emergency or when using equipment provided by the race committee.

16 Prizes

- 16.1 Prizes will be awarded for the first three placed boats in each event.
- 16.2 Other prizes will be award at the discussion of the Organising Authority.

17 Disclaimer

17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 Insurance

18.1 Each competing boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) per incident or the equivalent.
